PROGRAM ACHIEVEMENTS

Community Rehabilitation Services (CRS)

- 94 clients served onsite in CRS, a 10% increase from the previous FY
- 35,341 hours of individual and group instruction provided
- **13,200** hours of educational and recreational services provided in Life Transitions program
- **96%** success rate attained in program objectives for CRS clients (Goal- 90%)

Supported Employment

- **137** individuals served with employment assistance, job coaching, Project Search NKU internships, and follow-up support
- 78% employment retention of current and long-term clients in the community
- 26 new job placements in competitive employment
- 50+ businesses providing employment opportunities to clients

Production Services

- 40 businesses served with production assembly, packaging, labeling, workforce support, and/or light manufacturing services
- Provided workforce production training to 96 individuals with disabilities
- 3,000,000 pieces assembled, sorted, labeled and/or packaged for local businesses
- \$236,450 in wages paid to clients in training programs

Transportation Services

- **200** individuals/day provided with transportation to and from work, day/training programs, and nonemergency medical trips throughout six counties of NKY
- **53** passenger and/or wheelchair equipped vans and buses = NKY's largest fleet of para-transit vehicles to help facilitate a more accessible community
- 840,000 miles traveled for client transportation across NKY
